

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

Name of lode or vein is Quin Canyon No. 3

Date and description of location is March 6, 1971. About 1 mile east of the Quin Canyon road . Three large peaks on the east side. Near Lincoln-Nye County Line.

in the unknown Mining District, Lincoln County, Nevada.

The number of linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein each way from the point of discovery is 1100 feet northerly and 400 feet southerly together with 300 feet on each side of the middle of the vein, and the general course of the vein is northerly and southerly

The dimensions and location of the discovery shaft or its equivalent sunk upon the claim are a cut 7 x 13 x 6 feet deep, about 200 feet south of location monument. (cut made on Quin Canyon No. 7 claim to apply for this claim also)

The location and description of each corner and side center, with the markings thereon are: A post of at least 4 inches in diameter by 4 1/2 feet in length has been set one foot in the ground or placed in a mound of earth or stone 4 feet in diameter by 2 feet in height at the center of each side line and at the corners of this claim, each corner and side center being so marked so as to designate each corner and side center of said claim, and such markings were completed within 20 days after the posting of the Notice of Location.
