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WHEREAS, the note evidences a loan to Borrower in the principal amount specified therein, made with the purpose and intention that the Government, at any time, may assign the note and insure the payment thereof pursuant to the Consolidated Farmers Home Administration Act of 1961, or Title V of the Housing Act of 1949; and

WHEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, it may be assigned from time to time and each holder of the insured note, in turn, will be the insured lender; and

WHEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, the Government will execute and deliver to the insured lender along with the note an insurance endorsement insuring the payment of all amounts payable to the insured tender in connection with the loan; and

WHEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, the Government by agreement with the insured lender set forth in the insurence endorsement may be entitled to a specified portion of the payments on the note to be designated the "annual charge"; and

WHEREAS, a condition of the insurance of payment of the note will be that the holder will forego his rights and remedies against Borrower and any others in connection with the loan evidenced thereby, as well as any benefit of this instrument, and will accept the benefits of such insurance in lieu thereof, and upon the Government's request will assign the note to the Government; and

WHEREAS, it is the purpose and intent of this instrument that, among other things, at all times when the note is held by the Government, or in the event the Government should assign this instrument without insurance of the note, this instrument shall secure payment of the note; but when the note is held by an insured lender, this instrument shall not secure payment of the note or attach to the debt evidenced thereby, but as to the note and such debt shall constitute an indemnity mortgage to secure the Government against loss under its insurance endorsement by reason of any default by Borrower:

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the loan(s) BORROWER DOES HEREBY GRANT, BARGAIN, SELL, MORTGAGE, AND ASSIGN UNTO TRUSTEE THE FOLLOWING-DESCRIBED PROPERTY SITUATED IN

Lincoln COUNTY(IES), STATE OF NEVADA:

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A portion of Lot 3 Block 46 in Alamo, Lincoln County, Nevada, described as:

Beginning at the SE corner of said lot and running thence North along the East line of said lot 186 feet, thence at right angles West 154 feet, thence at right angles South 186 feet to the South line of said lot, thence along said South line 154 feet to the place of beginning.

SUBJECT to recorded rights of way;

TOGETHER WITH ALL RIGHTS, INTERESTS, EASEMENTS, HEREDITAMENTS AND APPURTENANCES THEREUNTO BELONGING, THE RENTS, ISSUES, AND PROFITS THEREOF AND REVENUES AND INCOME THEREFROM, ALL IMPROVEMENTS AND PERSONAL PROPERTY NOW OR LATER ATTACHED THERETO OR REASONABLE NECESSARY TO THE USE THEREOF, ALL WATER, WATER RIGHTS, WATER STOCK, WELLS, PUMPING PLANTS, AND EQUIPMENT PERTAINING THERETO, AND ALL PAYMENTS AT ANY TIME OWING TO BORROWER BY VIRTUE OF ANY SALE, LEASE, TRANSFER, CONVEYANCE, OR CONDEMNATION OF, OR INJURY TO, ANY PART THEREOF OR INTEREST THEREIN-ALL OF WHICH ARE HEREIN CALLED "THE PROPERTY";

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the property unto Trustee, his successors, grantees and assigns forever,

IN TRUST, NEVERCHELESS, (a) at all times when the note is held by the Government, or in the event the Government should assign this instrument without insurance of the payment of the note, to secure prompt payment of the note and any renewals and extensions thereof and any agreements contained therein, including any provision for the payment of an insurance or other charge, (b) at all times when the note is held by an insured lender, to secure performance of Borrower's agreement herein to indemnify and save hamiless the Government against loss under its insurance endorsement by reason of any default by Borrower, and (c) in any event and at all times to secure the prompt payment of all advances and expenditures made by the Government, with interest, as hereinafter described, and the performance of every covenant and agreement of Borrower contained herein or in supplementary agreement, the provisions of which are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

BORROWER for himself, his heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns WARRANTS the property and the title thereto unto Trustee for the benefit of the Government against all lawful claims and demands whatsoever except any liens, encumbrances, easements, reservations, or conveyances specified hereinabove, and COVENANTS AND AGREES as follows:

- (1) To pay promptly when due any indebtedness to the Government hereby secured and to indemnify and save harmless the Government against any loss under its insurance of payment of the note by reason of any default by Borrower. At all times when the note is held by an insured lender, Borrower shall continue to make payments on the note to the Government, as collection agent for the holder.
- (2) To pay to the Government such fees and other charges as may now or hereafter be required by regulations of the Farmers Home Administration.
- (3) At all times when the note is held by an insured lender, any amount due and unpaid under the terms of the note, less the amount of any annual charge, may be paid by the Government to the holder of the note as provided in the insurance endorsement for the account of Borrower. Any amount due and unpaid unpaid unpaid unpaid to the note, whether it is held by the Government or by an insured lender, may be credited by the Government on the note and thereupon shall constitute an advance by the Government for the account of Borrower. Any advance by the Government as described in this paragraph shall bear interest at the note rate from the date on which the amount of the advance was due to the date of payment to the Government.
- (4) WHETHER OR NOT THE NOTE IS INSURED BY THE GOVERNMENT, THE GOVERNMENT MAY AT ANY TIME PAY ANY OTHER AMOUNTS REQUIRED HEREIN TO BE PAID BY BORROWER AND NOT PAID BY HIM WHEN DUE, AS WELL AS ANY COSTS AND EXPENSES FOR THE PRESERVATION, PROTECTION, OR ENFORCEMENT OF THIS LIEN, AS ADVANCES FOR THE ACCOUNT OF BORROWER. ALL SUCH ADVANCES SHALL BEAR INTEREST AT THE RATE BORNE BY THE NOTE WHICH HAS THE HIGHEST INTEREST RATE.

- (5) ALL ADVANCES BY THE GOVERNMENT AS DESCRIBED IN THIS INSTRUMENT, WITH INTEREST, SHALL BE IMMEDIATELY DUE AND PAYABLE BY BORROWER TO THE GOVERNMENT WITHOUT DEMAND AT THE PLACE DESIGNATED IN THE LATEST NOTE AND SHALL BE SECURED HEREBY. No such advance by the Government shall relieve Borrower from breach of his covenant to pay. Such advances, with interest, shall be repaid from the first available collections received from Borrower. Otherwise, any payment made by Borrower may be upplied on the note or any indebtedness to the Government secured hereby, in any order the Government determines.
 - (6) To use the loan evidenced by the note solely for purposes authorized by the Government.
- (7) To pay when due all taxes, liens, judgments, encumbrances, and assessments lawfully attaching to or assessed against the property and promptly deliver to the Covernment without demand receipts evidencing such payments.
- (8) To keep the property insured as required by and under insurance policies approved by, delivered to, and retained by the Government.
- (9) To maintain improvements in good repair and make repairs required by the Government, operate the property in a good and husbandmanlike manner; comply with such farm conservation practices and farm and home management plans as the Government from time to time may prescribe; and not to abandon the property, or cause or permit waste, lessening or impairment of the security covered hereby, or, without the written consent of the Government, cut, remove, or lease any timber, gravel, oil, gas, coal, or other minerals except as may be necessary for ordinary domestic purposes.
 - (10) To comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations affecting the property.
- (11) To pay or reimburse the Government for expenses reasonably necessary or incidental to the protection of the lien and priority hereof and to the enforcement of or the compliance with the provisions hereof and of the note and any supplementary agreement (whether before or after default), including but not limited to costs of evidence of title to and survey of the property, costs of recording this and other instruments, attorneys' fees, trustees' fees, court costs, and expenses of advertising, selling, and conveying the property.
- (12) Neither the property nor any portion thereof or interest therein shall be leased, assigned, sold, transferred, or encumbered, voluntarily or otherwise, without the written consent of the Government. The Government shall have the sole and exclusive rights as beneficiary hereunder, including but not limited to the power to grant consents and subordinations, and to request full and partial reconveyances, and no insured lender shall have any right, title or interest in or to the lien or any benefits hereof.
- (13) At all reasonable times the Government and its agents may inspect the property to ascertain whether the covenants and agreements contained herein or in any supplementary agreement are being performed.
- (14) The Government may extend and defer the maturity of and renew and reamortize the debt evidenced by the note or any indebtedness to the Government secured hereby, release from liability to the Government any party so liable thereon, request reconveyances of portions of the property from and subordinate the lien hereof, and waive any other rights hereunder, without affecting the lien or priority hereof or the liability to the Government of Borrower or any other party for payment of the note or indebtedness secured hereby except as specified by the Government in writing.
- (15) If at any time it shall appear to the Government that Borrower may be able to obtain a loan from a production credit association. a Federal land bank, or other responsible cooperative or private credit source, at reasonable rates and terms for loans for similar purposes and periods of time. Borrower will, upon the Government's request, apply for and accept such loan in sufficient amount to pay the note and any indebtedness secured hereby and to pay for any stock necessary to be purchased in a cooperative lending agency in connection with such loan.
- (16) Default hereunder shall constitute default under any other real estate, or under any personal property or other, security instrument held or insured by the Government and executed or assumed by Borrower, and default under any such other security instrument shall constitute default hereunder.
- (17) SHOULD DEFAULT occur in the performance or discharge of any obligation secured by this instrument, or should any one of the parties named as Borrower die or be declared an incompetent, a bankrupt, or an insolvent, or make an assignment for the benefit of creditors, the Government, at its option, with or without notice, may: (a) declare the entire amount unpeid under the note and any indebtedness to the Government hereby secured immediately due and payable, (b) for the account of Borrower incur and pay reasonable expenses for repair or maintenance of and take possession of, operate or rent the property, (c) upon application by it and production of this instrument, without other evidence and without notice of hearing of said application, have a receiver appointed for the property, with the usual powers of receivers in like cases, and (d) authorize and request Trustee to foreclose this instrument and sell the property as provided by law.
- (18) At the request of the Government, Trustee may foreclose this instrument by advertisement and sale of the property as provided by law, for cash or secured credit at the option of the Government, personal notice of which sale need not be served on Borrower, such sale may be adjourned from time to time without other notice than oral proclamation at the time and place appointed for such sale and correction made on the posted notice; and at such sale the Government and its agents may bid and purchase as a stranger; Trustee at his option may conduct such sale without being personally present, through his delegate authorized by him for such purpose orally or in writing, and Trustee's execution of a conveyance of the property or any part thereof to any purchaser at foreclosure sale shall be conclusive evidence that the sale was conducted by Trustee personally or through his delegate dully authorized in accordance herewith.
- (19) The proceeds of foreclosure sale shall be applied in the following order to the payment of: (a) costs and expenses incident to enforcing or complying with the provisions hereof, (b) any prior liens required by law or a competent court to be so paid, (c) the debt evidenced by the note and all indebtedness to the Government secured hereby, (d) inferior liens of record required by law or a competent court to be so paid, (e) at the Government's option, any other indebtedness of Borrower owing to or insured by the Government, and (f) any balance to Borrower. In case the Government is the successful bidder at foreclosure or other sale of all or any part of the property, the Government may pay its share of the purchase price by crediting such amount on any debts of Borrower owing to or insured by the Government, in the order prescribed above.

(20) All powers and agencies granted in this instrument are coupled with an interest and are irrevocable by death or otherwise; and the rights and remedies provided in this instrument are cumulative to remedies provided by law.

(21) As against the debt evidenced by the note and any indebtedness to the Government hereby secured, with respect to the property, Borrower (a) hereby relinquishes, waives, and conveys all rights, inchoate or consummate, of descent, dower, curtesy, homestead, valuation, appraisal, and exemption, to which Borrower is or becomes entitled under the laws and constitution of the jurisdiction where the property lies, and (b) hereby agrees that any right provided by such laws or constitution for redemption or possession following foreclosure sale shall not apply, and that no right of redemption or possession shall exist after foreclosure sale.

(22) This instrument shall be subject to the present regulations of the Farmers Home Administration, and to its future regulations not inconsistent with the express provisions bereof.

(23) Notices gien hereunder shall be sent by certified mail, unless otherwise required by law, addressed, unless and until some other address is designated in a notice so given in the case of the Government or Trustee to Farmers Home Administration, United States Department of Agriculture, at Berkeley, California 94704, and in the case of Borrower to him at his post office address stated above.

(24) Upon full and final payment of all indebtedness hereby secured and the performance and discharge of each and every condition, agreement and obligation, contingent or otherwise, contained herein or secured hereby, the Government shall request Trustee to execute and deliver to Borrower at his above post office address a full reconveyance of the property within 60 days after written demand by Borrower, and Borrower hereby waives the benefits of all laws requiring earlier execution or delivery of such reconveyance.

(25) Borrower covenants and agrees that he will perform and complete all the action and fulfill all of the conditions necessary to perfect his rights to appropriate underground water to be produced from the well(s) on the said property and apply said water to beneficial use thereon; and in the event of Borrower's failure to do so, the Government shall have the right to complete such action, in which event all expenses and costs incident thereto shall become an indebtedness of Borrower in favor of the Government and shall be secured by this deed of trust.
