

# CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

Name of lode or vein is Beverly J #2

Date and description of location is March-29, 1971 - Approximately  
6000 feet of the Prince shaft the east side line  
is common with the west side line of Beverly J #1 Claim  
in the \_\_\_\_\_ Mining District, Lincoln County, Nevada.

The number of linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein each  
way from the point of discovery is 750 feet north and 750 feet
