

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

Name of lode or vein is BEVERLY J. #5

Date and description of location is MARCH 29, 1971 - Approximately
5000' South of the Prince Shaft - The NE side line
is common with the SW side line of the Beverly J #4

in the Piöche Mining District, Lincoln County, Nevada.

The number of linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein each way from the point of discovery is 250 feet northwesterly and 250 feet southeasterly (direction)

together with 300 feet on each side of the middle of the vein, (direction) and the general course of the vein is north and south (one direction) (other direction)
