

# CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

Name of lode or vein is Peava Mine

Date and description of location is 426/71 - 1 mi. S. of Oshes Wells (apparently)  
5 mi. N. of Beaman's road (cut 4 corners mineral?) 1/2 mi. E. of  
Peava rd. 4 high and plus to 20 large rock fragments <sup>now</sup> 200 ft. from location  
in the unknown Mining District, Lincoln County, Nevada.

The number of linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein each way from the point of discovery is 750 feet S. E. and 750 feet N. W. together with 300 feet on each side of the middle of the vein, (direction) and the general course of the vein is S. E. and N. W. (one direction) (other direction)

The dimensions and location of the discovery shaft or its equivalent sunk upon the claim are open cut 4 x 6 x 15 ft. at discovery monument

The location and description of each corner and side center, with the markings thereon are: A post of at least 4 inches in diameter by 4 1/2 feet in length has been set one foot in the ground or placed in a mound of earth or stone 4 feet in diameter by 2 feet in height at the center of each side line and at the corners of this claim, each corner and side center being so marked so as to designate each corner and side center of said claim, and such markings were completed within 20 days after the posting of the Notice of Location.
