
Reginald G. Lee, being duly sworn according to law, deposes and says:

HUMBLE OIL AND REFINING COMPANY, LESSEE AND OPTIONEE, and consisted of:


- 1- Construction of roads to drill sites

now under study and evaluation.


The said Core Drilling and road building were performed on the Puritan, Yankee
