Date and description of location is September 4, 1971; the northerly side line is common to the southerly side line of the Quo Vadis No. 2 lode claim. The discovery monument is about 1,890' south 81° West from the Reference point, which is also the southerly end center of the Quo Vadis No. 1 claim.

in the QUINN CANYON Mining District, Lincoln County, Nevada.

The number of linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein each way from the point of discovery is 25 feet Northwest and 1,475 feet southeast together with 300 feet on each side of the middle of the vein. (direction) and the general course of the vein is Northeasterly and Southwesterly (one direction) (other direction)

The location work consisted of making the maps as provided in N.R.S. 517.040 Transit tie to the point of reference from the SE cor. Sec. 33 T 2 N; R 56 E and a map filed separately for Quo Vadis 1, 2, 3, 4, and 5 The location and description of each corner and side center, with the markings thereon are: A post of at least 4 inches in diameter by 4 1/2 feet in length has been set one foot in the ground or placed in a mound of earth or stone 4 feet in diameter by 2 feet in height at the center of each side line and at the corners of this claim, each corner and side center being so marked so as to designate each corner and side center of said claim, and such markings were completed within 20 days after the posting of the Notice of location.
