

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

Name of lode or vein is Hillside #2

Date and description of location is Sept 1, 1971 Hillside #2 abuts the Hillside #1 on the southeasterly end line of Hillside #1

This claim covers the abandoned A.M.W. #2 claim in the Templute Mining District, Lincoln County, Nevada.

The number of linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein each way from the point of discovery is 1450 feet SEasterly and 50 feet Nwesterly together with 300 feet on each side of the middle of the vein. (direction) (direction) and the general course of the vein is westerly and Easterly. (one direction) (other direction)

The location work consisted of making the maps as provided in N.R.S. 517.040

The location and description of each corner and side center, with the markings thereon are: A post of at least 4 inches in diameter by 4 1/2 feet in length has been set one foot in the ground or placed in a mound of earth or stone 4 feet in diameter by 2 feet in height at the center of each side line and at the corners of this claim, each corner and side center being so marked so as to designate each corner and side center of said claim, and such markings were completed within 20 days after the posting of the Notice of location.
