Name of the Lode or Vein is QUEEN MARY No. 7  
Located January 3, 1973. South side of Queen Mary No. 7 is contiguous  
with the North side of Queen Mary No. 6. The North end of Ausen Mary No. # 7  
is contiguous with South end of Queen Mary No. 9.  
in the VIOLA Mining District, Lincoln County, Nevada.

The number of Linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein
