Name of the Lode or Vein is Florite Basin No. 8  
Florite Basin No. 8 is contiguous with Florite Basin No. 9 on South Side and  
Little Red Mountain No. 11 on East end, Florite Basin No. 5 on West end.  
S. E. corner is 6665 feet 70 W. of N. of Section Corner described below.  
 in the VIOLA Mining District, Lincoln County, Nevada.

The number of Linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein  
 each way from the point of discovery is 1500 feet Easterly and \_\_\_\_\_
