CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

Name of Lode or Vein is SILVER HORN No. 2

Silver Horn No. 2 is contiguous with Silver Horn No. 1 on the West End.

In the VIOLA Mining District Lincoln County, Nevada.

The number of Linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein is 1500 feet Easterly from point of discovery together with 300 feet on each side of the middle of the vein. The general course of the vein is Easterly and Westerly.

Location work consisted of making maps as provided in N.R.S. 517.040.

The location and description of each corner and side center, with the markings thereon are a post of at least 4 inches in diameter by 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet in length that has been set one foot in the ground or placed in a mound of earth or stone four feet in diameter by two feet in height at the center of each side line and at the corners of this claim, each side center and each corner being so marked as to designate each corner and side center of said claim, and such marking were completed within 20 days after the posting of the Notice of Location.
