

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

Name of lode or vein is SILVER HORN No. 3

This claim is contiguous with Silver Horn No. 2 on the West End.

In the VIth Mining District Lincoln County, Nevada.

The number of linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein is 1500 feet westerly from point of discovery together with 300 feet on each side of the vein. The general course of the vein is easterly and westerly.

Location work consisted of marking maps as provided in Nev. St. 517.040.

The location and description of each corner and side center, with the markings thereon were a part of at least 4 inches in diameter by 40 feet in length that has been set one foot in the ground or placed in a mound of earth or stone four feet in diameter by two feet in height at the center of each side line and at the corners of this claim, each side center and each corner being so marked so as to distinguish distinctly each corner and side center of said claim, and such marking were completed within 20 days after the posting of the Notice of Location.
