

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

NAME OF The lode or vein is FLUORITE BASIN No. 11
Located November 10, 1973. Discovery Monument at center of S.W. end of claim.

This claim is contiguous with Fluorite Basin No. 1, on North side and
Fluorite Basin No. 10 on West End, and Mercury 8 on East End.

In the VIOLA Mining District, Lincoln County, Nevada.

The number of linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein
each way from the point of discovery is 1500 feet Easterly and
 feet together with 300 feet each side of the
middle of the vein, and the general course of the vein is Easterly
and Westerly.

Location work consisted of making maps as provided in N.R.S. 517.040.

The locations and description of each corner and side center, with the
markings thereon are: A post at least 4 inches in diameter by $\frac{1}{2}$ feet
in length that has been set one foot in the ground or placed in a mound
of earth and stone four feet in diameter by two feet in height at the
center of each side line and at the corners of this claim, each side
center and each corner being so marked so as to designate each corner
and side center of said claim, and such markings were completed within
20 days after the posting of Notice of Location.
