

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

NAME OF The lode or vein is MERCURY No. 6  
 Located November 20, 1973. Discovery monument at center of East end of Claim.

This claim is contiguous with Mercury No. 5 on North, Fluorite Basin No. 1  
 on West end, Mercury No. 8 on South Side.

In the VIOLA Mining District, Lincoln County, Nevada.

The number of linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein  
 each way from the point of discovery is 1500 feet Northwest and  
\_\_\_\_\_ feet \_\_\_\_\_ together with 300 feet each side of the  
 middle of the vein, and the general course of the vein is Northwest  
 and Southeast.

Location work consisted of making maps as provided in N.R.S. 517.040.

The locations and description of each corner and side center, with the  
 markings thereon are: A post at least 4 inches in diameter by 4 1/2 feet  
 in length that has been set one foot in the ground or placed in a mound  
 of earth and stone four feet in diameter by two feet in height at the  
 center of each side line and at the corners of this claim, each side  
 center and each corner being so marked so as to designate each corner  
 and side center of said claim, and such markings were completed within  
 20 days after the posting of Notice of Location.
