

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

Name of Lode or Vein is White Point No. 1

Description of location October 15, 1974. The discovery monument is approx. 850 feet southwesterly from the Northwest corner No. 3 of Patented claim

"Monitor No. 2" Survey No. 3235. The East side line of this claim joins the west side of Patented Claim "Monitor No. 2" in the Eagle Valley Mining District, Lincoln County, Nevada.

The number of linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein each way from the point of discovery is 850 feet northerly and 650 (direction) feet southerly together with 300 feet on each side of the middle of the (direction) vein, and the general course of the vein is Northerly and southerly (one direction) (other direction)

The Location work consisted of making the maps as provided in N.R.S. 517.040

The location and description of each corner and side center, with the marking thereon are: A post of at least 4 inches in diameter by 4 1/2 feet in length has been set one foot in the ground or placed in a mound of earth or stone 4 feet in diameter by 2 feet in height at the center of each side line and at the corners of this claim, each corner and side center being so marked so as to designate each corner and side center of said claim, and such markings were completed within 20 days after the posting of the Notice of Location.
