

NOTICE OF LOCATION

(SECTS 2301 TO 2324, PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE)

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Please take notice that:

1. The name of this claim is the Bornite #9 Lode Mining Claim. Said claim is situated in the name unknown Mining District, County of Lincoln, State of Nevada. Located this 21 day of March, 1975, when discovery was made and copy of the original notice posted.

2. That the undersigned locators are citizens of the United States or have declared their intention to become such, and have discovered mineral bearing rock in place thereon and do locate and claim same for mining purposes.

3. That the number of linear feet in length along the course of the vein each way from the point of discovery whereon we have erected a monument, is north 400 feet, south 1100 feet; that the total length does not exceed 1500 feet. That the width on the East side is 300 feet; that the width on the West side is 300 feet; that the total width does not exceed 600 feet, that the end lines are parallel; that the general course of the vein or lode as near as may be, is in a north and south direction; that the boundaries of this claim may be readily traced, and are defined as follows, to wit:

COMMENCING at north west 90° north direction from the discovery monument, 400 feet therefrom, the n-w. corner thence 600 ft to the N-E corner-post marked Bornite #9 NE. corner thence 700 ft southerly to the side center post marked S-S-C #9 thence 750 ft southerly to the southeast corner-post mark S-E corner #9 thence 100 ft southerly to the S-E corner post #9 is East of #8 South of #2

4. That this claim can be identified by its proximity to the following natural object or permanent monument, to wit: Approximately 1/2 mile northerly of Wire Grass Spring and approximately 1/4 mile north west of F Harkberry Spring
