

NOTICE OF LOCATION

(SECTS 2301 TO 2324, PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE)

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Please take notice that:

1. The name of this claim is the Bornite #10 Lode Mining Claim. Said claim is situated in the Name unknown District, County of Lincoln, State of Nevada. Located this 21 day of March, 1975, when discovery was made and copy of the original notice posted.

2. That the undersigned locators are citizens of the United States or have declared their intention to become such, and have discovered mineral bearing rock in place thereon and do locate and claim same for mining purposes.

3. That the number of linear feet in length along the course of the vein each way from the point of discovery whereon we have erected a monument, is North 750 feet, South 750 feet; that the total length does not exceed 1500 feet. That the width on the East 300 feet, that the width on the West 300 feet; that the total width does not exceed 600 feet, that the end lines are parallel; that the general course of the vein or lode as near as may be, is in a North erly and South erly direction; that the boundaries of this claim may be readily traced, and are defined as follows, to wit:

COMMENCING at Northwest cor. in a North erly direction from the discovery monument, 750 feet therefrom, the N.W. cor. thence 600 ft to the N.E. cor. post marked Bornite #10 N.E. cor. thence 750 ft southerly to the side center post marked S.S.C #10 thence 750 ft southerly to the S.E. cor. post mark SE cor. #10 thence 600 ft westerly to the S.W. cor. post #10 is E. of #9 1/2 mi. south of #1. 12 S. That this claim can be identified by its proximity to the following natural object or permanent monument, to-wit: approximately 1/2 mile northerly of Vire Grass Spring and approximately 1/4 mile northwest of Huckleberry Spring. This notice is intended as an original notice of location and is posted on this claim and a true copy thereof is to be recorded with the County Recorder of this County Lincoln, Pioche, Nev.

That all the dips, variations, spurs, angles and all veins, ledges, or deposits within the lines of this claim, together with all water and timber and any other rights appurtenant, allowed by the law of this State or of the United States are hereby claimed.
