NOTICE OF LOCATION

(SECTS. 2301 TO 2324. PUBLIC RESOURCES CODE)

TO WHOM IT MAY CONCERN: Please take notice that:

1. The name of this claim is the Bornite # 11 Lode Mining Claim. Said claim is situated in the panie unknown Mining District, County of Lincoln, State of Nevada. Located this 21 day of March, 1972, when discovery was made and copy of the original notice posted.

2. That the undersigned locators are citizens of the United States or have declared their intention to become such, and have discovered mineral bearing rock in place thereon and do locate and claim same for mining purposes.

3. That the number of linear feet in length along the course of the vein each way from the point of discovery wherein we have erected a monument, is North 500 feet; South 500 feet; that the width on the East 300 feet; that the side is 300 feet; that the width on the West 300 feet; that the total width does not exceed 600 feet, that the end lines are parallel; that the general course of the vein or lode as near as may be, is in a northerly and southwesterly direction; that the boundaries of this claim may be readily traced, and are defined as follows, to wit:

COMMENCING at N. W. cor. in a north erly direction from the discovery monument, 500 feet therefrom, N. W. cor. thence 600 ft. to the N.
