## · CONTRACT OF SALE FOR REAL ESTATE

## WITNESSTER:

That in consideration of the mutual covenants herein contained, the Sellers herein agree to sell and convey, and the Puyers herein agree to runchase all that certain property, hereinafter referred to as "said property" situated in the Youn of Alamo, County of Lincoln, State of Nevada, together with all its temements, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereon, and described as follows:

That mortion of Lot Four (4) in block fourty-five (45) of Alamo Townsite described as follows, to wit:

Perinning at the Northeast corner of said Lot Four(4), running thence Southerly along the East Line thereof a distance of fifty-nine(59) feet; thence westerly and parallel to the North line of said lot Four(4) a distance of one hundred fourty-six (165) feet, thence Northerly and parallel to the aforesaid East line a distance of fifty-nine (59) feet to a coint on the North line of said lot Four(4); thence Easterly along said Worth line a distance of one hundred fourty-six (114) feet to the roint of beginning.

This contract of sale is made upon the following terms and conditions:

 Purchase price: The total purchase price of said property is \$1.750.00 payable as follows:

- A. Monthly installment payments of \$75.00 per month, which sum includes interest at the rate of 6% per annum on unpaid balance. The aforesaid monthly payment includes all principal and interest and is payable on the 25th day of each succeeding month beginning Oct. 2%, 1975, and is payable directly to Sellers.
- 2. Prepayment: There shall be no prepayment penalty as between any financial obligations of Puyers to Sellers. Buyers reserve the right to make larger payments at any time thereby stooping interest on such amount so paid.
- 3. Grant, Pargain and Sale Deed: Sellers will execute a Grant, Bargain, and Sale Deed and shall deliver the same to Suyers upon the payment and performance of all obligations of Buyers under and pursuant to the terms of this contract of sale.
- ii. Possession: Possession of said property has been given to Buyers who have the right to retain possession pursuant to the terms of this contract.
- 5. Taxes, assessments, utilities and expenses for improvement and repairs:
  Buyers agree to pay all state, county and city taxes and assessments on said
  property and all utilities occurring after date of possession.
- 6. Sellers agree that as long as this contract is executory they will not convey, assign or encumber said property described herein, or do anything that will affect the title to said property, and that said property is free and clear of all liers and obligations other than those disclosed herein.
- 7. Default of Foyers: In the event Buyers default in any installment payment due herein and remain in default for a period of 60 days, after written notice of said default has been received by them, then Sellers shall have the

right to terminate this contract and Sellers may retain any and all interest maid and received by Sellers from Buyers as and for rent and liquidated damages and Puyers are relieved from any further obligation herein.

A. This agreement shall be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators and assigns of the parties hereto.
