THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the BUSH No. 8 lode mining claim was located by:

on the 11th day of October, 1975, situated in the Highland Mining District, Lincoln County, State of Nevada, in Section 17 & 20, Township 1 N, Range 66 E

We (or I) claim 1500 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 1490 feet from the location monument in a N. 69°15' E. direction, and 10 feet in a S. 69°15' W. direction, together with 150 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The northwest corner is marked by a 4"x4"x4' wooden post 3 feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the BUSH No. 8 Claim;" the southwest corner is marked by a 4"x4"x4' wooden post 3 feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the BUSH No. 8 Claim;" the southeast corner is marked by a rock mound 3 feet high, inscribed "SE Corner of the BUSH No. 8 Claim;" the northeast corner is marked by a blazed tree 3 feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the BUSH No. 8 Claim." There is also a blazed tree 3' at the center of each side line.

The monumentation and marking of the corners was completed by the 17th day of October, 1975 (must be within 20 days of posting notice of location)

The location work consisted of making a claim map as provided in NRS 517.040. Two copies of this claim map have been filed with the Lincoln County Recorder, and the \$15.00 lode claim filing fee has been paid to the County Recorder.
