NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the undersigned, having complied with the requirements of SECTION 2324 of the REVISED STATUTES of the United States, and the Local Laws, Customs and Regulations of this District, have located 1500 feet in length by 600 feet in width, on this the Lucky Linda No 1 Lode, Vein

- DIAGRAM OF CLAIM - The location (discovery point) and corner monuments should be designated on the accompanying diagram to make the record of claim more perfect.

No location of a mining claim can be made until the discovery of the vein or lode within the limits of the ground claimed.
