NOTE

DIAGRAM OF CLAIM — The location (discovery point) and corner monuments should be designated on the accompanying diagram to make the record of claim note correct.

A mining claim must not exceed 1500 feet in length along the vein or lode, by 600 feet in width, 300 feet on each side of center of vein at surface.

No location of a mining claim can be made until the discovery of the vein or lode within the limits of the ground claimed.

The claim must be distinctly marked on the ground so its boundaries can be readily traced.

A severe penalty is provided by law for locating or defacing the stakes or monuments of a mining claim.

Claims located on Sunday or holidays are void.

All valuable mineral deposits in lands of the United States shall be open to all persons and they shall have the right to locate their claims thereon.

The location notes must be filed for record with the County Recorder of the County in which claim is located.
