

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

NAME OF the lode or vein is SOUTH PAW No. 3, Located July 6, 1978.
The Discovery Monument is located at the S.E. end of claim. This
is contiguous with South Paw No. 2 on its N.E. end.

UNKNOWN

In the WOLLA Mining District, Lincoln County, Nevada.

The number of linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein
each way from the point of discovery is 1500 feet N.E. and
 feet together with 300 feet each side of the
middle of the vein, and the general course of the vein is N.E.
and S.W.

Location work consisted of making maps as provided in N.R.S. 517.040.

The locations and description of each corner and side center, with the
markings thereon are: A post at least 4 inches in diameter by 4½ feet
in length that has been set one foot in the ground or placed in a mound
of earth and stone four feet in diameter by two feet in height at the
center of each side line and at the corners of this claim, each side
center and each corner being so marked so as to designate each corner

20 days after the posting of Notice of Location.
