NICHOLAS R. NUTTYCOMBE, being first duly sworn, deposes and says:

That he is a citizen of the United States of America, is more than eighteen (18) years of age, and resides in Tucson, Arizona;

That he is personally acquainted with those certain unpatented lode mining claims situated in the Viola mining district, Lincoln County, Nevada, more particularly described in Exhibit A which is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference;

That for the assessment year beginning the 1st day of September, 1978 and ending the 1st day of September, 1979 at least One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) worth of work and improvements were done and performed on or for the benefit of each of the said unpatented lode mining claims listed on Exhibit A, and that such work and improvements were done and performed for the purpose of complying with the laws of the United States of America and the State of Nevada pertaining to assessment or annual work for the purpose of holding title to said unpatented lode mining claims for the valuable mineral contained therein, and that the value of such work and improvements was in excess of Four Thousand, Six Hundred Dollars (\$4,600.00);

That said unpatented lode mining claims are divided between one contiguous group of thirty-five (35) claims, one contiguous group of four (4) claims, two separate groups of three (3) contiguous claims each, and one single isolated claim; and that work and improvements were done and performed upon each of the groups of contiguous claims and upon the single isolated claim for the purpose of developing the mineral potential in each of the said claims described in Exhibit A, which claims are under option to AMAX Exploration, Inc.; and that the work was performed on behalf of the owners named in Exhibit A;

That the improvements and work to be described hereinafter were performed upon the individual groups of contiguous claims and the single isolated claim at the times or during the periods indicated, by the companies and individuals named, and at the costs indicated:

1) For the contiguous group of unpatented lode mining claims comprising Blue Nose #1 through Blue Nose #35, in excess of Thirty-five Hundred Dollars (\$3,500.00) was expended upon an Induced Polarization survey carried out during the period October 3, 1978 through October 16, 1978 by Applied Geophysical Inc. of Salt Lake City, Utah at the request and expense of AMAX Exploration, Inc.

In the course of this survey, Induced Polarization readings were collected along five parallel lines which crossed and entirely encompassed said group of contiguous claims as shown in Exhibit B which is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference. Portions of the various survey lines crossed the following individual Blue Nose claims of said contiguous group: \$2, \$4, \$6, \$7, \$8, \$9, \$11, \$13, \$15, \$17, \$18, \$19, \$20, \$21, \$22, \$25, \$27, \$28, \$29, \$30, \$32, \$33, and \$34.

The cumulative data collected allowed an interpretation of the resistivity and chargeability characteristics of the rocks at depth below said group of contiguous claims, and helped to define structural boundaries.

The names and qualifications of the individuals who conducted the survey and interpreted the data are given in Exhibit C which is attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference.

- 2) For the single, separate unpatented lode mining claim, Blue Nose #36, which previously lacked road access, approximately 2,500 reet of road was constructed to provide access. This road was constructed by an employee of Tennessee Tungsten, Inc. of Pioche, Nevada, at the request and expense of AMAX Exploration, Inc., using a Euclid C-6 Crawler tractor. This work was done on September 26, 1978 at a cost of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).
- 3) For the contiguous group of three (3) unpatented lode mining claims, comprising Blue Nose #37 through #39, the existing access road was repaired and renewed, and a bedrock exposure was cut along a North 750 West trending mineralized fault that extends through parts of both Blue Nose #37 and #38. This work was carried out by an employee of Tennessee Tungsten, Inc. of Pioche, Nevada, at the request and expense of AMAX Exploration, Inc., using a Euclid C-6 Crawler tractor. It was completed on September 26, 1978 at a cost of not less than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00).
- 4) For the contiguous group of four (4) unpatented lode mining claims comprising Blue Nose #40 through #43, silver-bearing veins on claims Blue Nose #41 and #42 were opened up and exposed for subsequent mapping and sampling, and the existing access road to this contiguous group of claims from the main contiguous group (Blue Nose #1 through #35) was repaired and renewed. This work was completed on September 25, 1978 by an employee of Tennessee Tungsten at the request and expense of AMAX Exploration, Inc. and cost not less than Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00).
- 5) For the contiguous group of three (3) unpatented lode mining claims comprising Blue Nose #44 through #46, the existing access road to them from the main group of claims (Blue Nose #1 through #35) was repaired and renewed, and two drill sites with access roads were constructed. One of the drill sites is adjacent to the major east-west trending vein on Blue Nose claim #44, and the other is on Blue Nose claim #45 adjacent to a continuation of the same vein. This work was carried out by an employee of Tennessee Tungsten, Inc. of Pioche, Nevada, at the request and expense of AMAX Exploration, Inc. and cost not less than Three Hundred Dollars (\$300.00). The work was completed on September 23, 1978 using a Euclid C-6 Crawler tractor.


