³ Witnesses are optional and not required.
⁴ Public Resources Code Section provides, in part, as follows: "Within 90 days after the posting of his notice of location upon a lode mining claim . . . the locator shall record a true copy of the notice together with a statement of the markings of the boundaries as required in this chapter, and the performance of the required discovery work, in the office of the county recorder of the county in which such claim is situated. The county recorder shall receive a fee of one dollar (\$1) for this service."
