STATEMENT OF THE MARKINGS OF THE BOUNDARIES AND OF PERFORMANCE OF DISCOVERY WORK

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN by the undersigned Locator of the within described Lode Mining Claim, in accordance with the provisions of Section 2313 of the Public Resources Code of the State of California relating to mining claims, as follows:

(1) There has been erected at the discovery point, at each corner and at the center of each end line of said amended claim,

(2) The Locator has performed discovery work as required by Section 2304, Public Resources Code as follows:

(3) That the discovery work indicated above has been completed within ninety (90) days from the date of location of said amended claim.

Section 2310 of California Public Resources Code provides as follows: 'If at any time the locator of any mining claim, or his assigns, apprehends that his original location notice was defective, erroneous, or that the requirements of the law had not been complied with before filing, or in case the original notice was made prior to the passage of this chapter, and he is desirous of securing the benefit of this chapter, such locator, or his assigns, may file an amended notice, subject to the provisions of this chapter. If such amended location notice does not interfere with the existing rights of others at the time of posting and filing the amended location notice. No amended location notice or the record thereof shall preclude the claimant or claimants from proving any such title as he or they may have held under previous locations. Witnesses are optional and are not required. Public Resources Code Section 2313 provides, in part, as follows: 'Within 90 days after the posting of his notice of location upon a lode mining claim, the locator shall record a true copy of this notice together with a statement of the markings of the boundaries as required in this chapter, and of the performance of the required discovery work, in the office of the county recorder of the county in which such claim is situated. The county recorder shall receive a fee of one dollar (\$1) for this service.' Insert herein the following words: 'a post not less than four (4) inches in diameter' or 'a stone monument, at least eighteen (18) inches high'. Section 2304, Public Resources Code, reads, in part, as follows: '(a) Within 90 days after the date of location of any lode mining claim hereafter located, the locator or locators thereof shall sink a discovery shaft upon the claim to a depth of at least 10 feet from the lowest part of the rim of the shaft at the surface, or shall drive a tunnel, adit, or open cut upon the claim to at least 10 feet below the surface. A lode mining claim is null and void unless such discovery work is duly performed and a true copy of location notice recorded within ninety (90) days from date of location.'
