

# CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

Name of Lode or Vein is Silverhorn #104

This claim is 1500 feet long and 600 feet wide.

In the Bristol Mining District, Lincoln County, Nevada.

The number of linear feet claimed in length along the course of the <sup>claim</sup> vein each way from the point of discovery is 1490 feet East and 10 feet West together with 300 feet <sup>in width</sup> ~~each~~ <sup>each</sup> side of the middle of the <sup>claim</sup> vein, and the general course of the vein is East and West (one direction) (other direction)
