U.S.M.M. #2 LOCATION BEING IN THE NE $\frac{1}{4}$ & NW $\frac{1}{4}$ OF SECTION
14 T.4S, R.56E., MT. DIABLO BASE

In the TEMPLETT Mining District, Lincoln County, Nevada.

The number of linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein eastward from the point of discovery is 750 feet NORTH and 750 feet SOUTH together with 300 feet on each side of the middle of the vein, and the general course of the vein is NORTH and SOUTH.

The location work consisted of making the maps as provided in N.R.S. 517.040.

The location and description at each corner and side center, with the marking thereof, were: A post of at least 4 inches in diameter by 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet in length being set upright in the ground or placed in a mound of earth or stone 4 feet square by 2 feet in height at the center of each side line and at the corners of this claim, each corner and side center being so marked so as to identify each corner and side center of said claim, and such markings were made out within 20 days after the posting of the Notice of Location.
