U.S.M.M. #2 LOCATION BEING IN THE SE 1/4 & SW 1/4 OF SECTION 11  
AND THE NE 1/4 & NW 1/4 OF SEC 12 MT. DIABLO BASE T.45, R.56 E.

In the TEMPERUTE Mining District, Lincoln County, Nevada.

The number of linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein each way from the point of discovery is 750 feet NORTH and 750 feet SOUTH together with 300 feet on each side of the middle of the vein, and the general course of the vein is NORTH and SOUTH

The location work consisted of making the maps as provided in N.R.S. 517.040.

The location and description of each corner and side center, with the marking thereon: A post of at least 4 inches in diameter by 4 1/2 feet in length has been set on foot in the ground or placed in a mound of earth or stone - 1 foot in diameter by 2 feet in height at the center of each side line and at the corners of this claim, each corner and side center being so marked so as to designate each corner and side center of said claim, and such markings were completed within 20 days after the posting of the Notice of Location.
