in the TEMPERUTE Mining District, Lincoln County, Nevada.

The number of linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein
each way from the point of discovery is 750 feet NORTH and 750
feet SOUTH together with 300 feet on each side of the middle of the
vein, and the general course of the vein is NORTH and SOUTH
(one direction) (other direction)

The location work consisted of making the maps as provided in N.R.S. 517.040.
