IN TRUST, NEVERTHELESS, (a) at all times when the note is held by the Government, or in the event the Government should assign this instrument without insurance of the payment of the note to secure prompt payment of the note and any renewals and extensions thereof and any agreements contained therein, including any provisions for the payment of an insurance or other charge, (b) at all times when the note is held by an insurance holder, to secure performance of Borrower's agreement herein to indemnify and save harmless the Government against loss under its insurance contract by reason of any default by Borrower, and (c) in any event and at all times to secure the prompt payment of all advances and expenditures with Covernment with interest, as begingfire described and the performance of every covernat and agreement of made by the Government, with interest, as hereinafter described and the performance of every covenant and agreement of Borrower contained herein or in any supplementary agreement.

BORROWER for Borrower's self, Borrower's heirs, executors, administrators, successors and assigns WARRANTS the property unto Trustee for the benefit of the Government against all lawful claims and demands whatsoever except any liens, encumbrances, easements, reservations, or conveyance specified hereinabove, and COVENANTS AND AGREES as follows:

- (1) To pay promptly when due any indebtedness to the Government hereby secured and to indemnify and save harmless the Government against any loss under its insurance of payment of the note by reason of any default by Borrower. (10) To comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations affecting the property.

(11) To pay or reimburse the Government for expenses reasonably necessary or incidental to the protection of the lien and priority hereof and to the enforcement of or the compliance with the provisions hereof and of the note and any supplementary agreement (whether before or after default) including but not limited to costs of evidence of title to and survey of the property, costs of recording this and other instruments, attorneys' fees, trustees' fees, court costs, and expenses of advertising, selling, and conveying the property.
