SUMMARY REPORT
September 30, 1980

This detailed report is filed in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code, Section 28-1 for the S.L. Nos. 1 - 29, 31, 33 and 34, a contiguous group of 32 lode mining claims situated in the Stateline Mining District of Lincoln County, Nevada.

The work consisted of detailed geological mapping of the entire claim group and of rock-chip sampling of portions of the claims, to evaluate the discovery of valuable mineral deposits located thereon and to assist in planning further exploration and development work.

The work was performed in the periods:

20 October to 30 November, 1979
3 August to 31 August, 1980

under the direct supervision of Keith P. Rhea of 2189 South Flower Way, Lakewood, Colorado 80227, a geologist of 15 years experience in mineral exploration with a degree from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (B.S., Geol. and Geophy., 1959) and from the University of California at Berkeley (M.A., Geology, 1966).

The cost of the survey exceeded \$3,200.00 and was paid for by AMAX Exploration, Inc., owners of the subject mining claims.

The basic findings of the detailed geologic mapping and rock-chip sampling indicate the claim block is underlain by hydrothermally altered and quartz veined volcanics and possible intrusive rocks with chemical values that may be indicative of concealed economic mineralization.
