AMENDED DECREE OF DIVORCE

This cause came on regularly this day for trial; Plaintiff appeared in person and by and through his attorney, JOHN S.

McGIMSEY: Defendant was not present, but heretofore filed herein, in proper person, her duly acknowledged Answer, authorizing this Court to hear this cause without further delay or notice; the Court, having heard the testimony, having examined the proofs offered and being fully advised in the premises, finds the facts as follows:

- 1. Plaintiff is a resident of the State of Nevada and for a period of more than six weeks immediately preceding the commencement of this action has been and is now a bonafide and actual resident of Lincoln County, Nevada, having been corporally present therein for said period of time.
- Plaintiff and Defendant intermarried on or about
 June 4, 1977, in Alamo, Lincoln County, Nevada, and ever since have been and now are husband and wife.
- 3. That two children have been born the issue of said marriage, to-wit: a dauther, JESSICA R. BAKER, born November 25, 1977; and a daughter, ERICA H. BAKER, born December 15, 1978;

 that Defendant is a fit and proper person to have the care, custody and control of said child.

 4. That there is community property consisting of a 1977 Chevrolet Nova, House and lot described as Lot 19, Alamo South Subdivision; that it would be proper for the Court to award the 1977 Chevrolet Nova to Defendant, she to assume financial obligations thereon, and to award the house and lot described above to Plaintiff, he to assume financial obligations thereon.

5. That the parties are incompatible in their married life.

As conclusions of law from the foregoing facts the Court finds that Plaintiff is entitled to a judgment dissolving the bonds of matrimony heretofore and now existing between Plaintiff and Defendant upon the ground of Incompatibility. Judgment will be entered accordingly.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the bonds of matrimony now and heretofore existing between Plaintiff and Defendant be, and the same are hereby, wholly dissolved and held for naught and said Plaintiff is hereby awarded an absolute decree of divorce from Defendant upon the ground of Incompatibility and each of the respective parties is hereby restored to the status of a single and unmarried person.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the care, custody and control of JESSICA R. BAKER and ERICA H. BAKER is hereby awarded to Defendant. Plaintiff is ordered to pay \$75 per month, per child, as and for child support beginning with the 15th of September, 1980 and continuing each and every calendar month thereafter until each child reaches the age of matority. marries or is otherwise emancipated. Reasonable rights of visitation are reserved to Plaintiff so long as he is current in the payment of child support.
