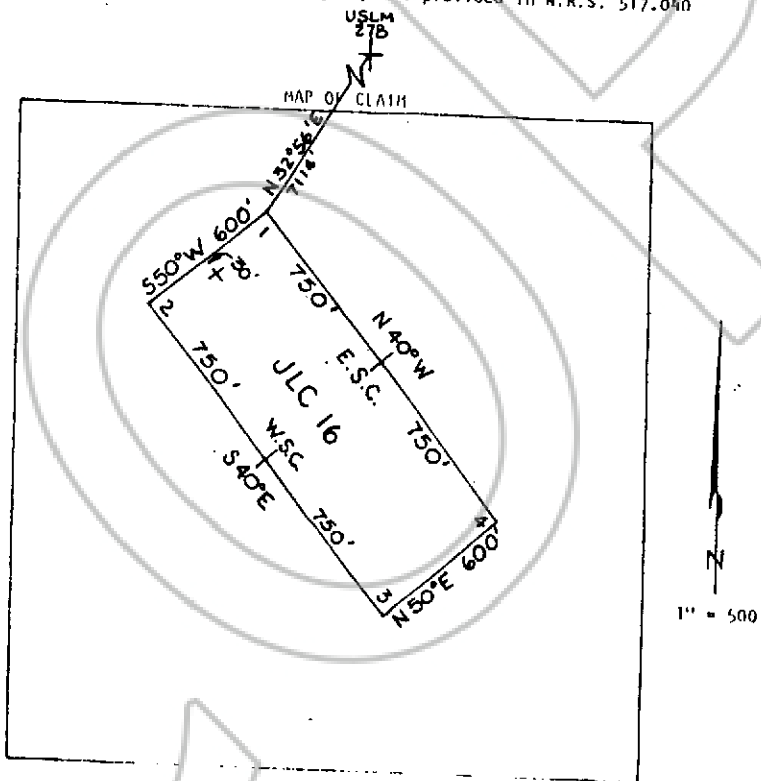
KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that STEVEN WEISS AGENT FOR
