Name of Lode or Vein is CEDAR # 10

Claim 600 x 1500'

In the Benton Mining District, LINCOLN County, Nevada. The number of linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein each way from the point of discovery is 1480 feet SOUTH and 20 feet NORTH together with 50 feet on each side of the middle of the vein, and the general course of the vein is NORTH and SOUTH.

The location work consisted of making the marks as provided in N.R.S. 517.040.

The location and description at each corner and mid-center, with the markings thereon are: A post of about 4 inches in diameter by 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet in length has been set one-third in the ground or placed in a mound of earth or stone 4 feet in diameter by 2 feet in height at the center of each side line and at the corners of this claim, each corner and mid-center being so marked as to distinguish each corner and mid-center of said claim, and such markings were completed within 30 days after the posting of the notice of location.
