GENERAL STATEMENT OF LOCATION

CEDAR 600 x 1500

In the Bristol Range, Lincoln County, Nevada, the number of linear feet elided in length along the course of the vein each way from the point of discovery is 1480 feet SOUTH and 20 feet NORTH together with 100 feet on each side of the middle of the vein, and the general course of the vein is NORTH and SOUTH.

The location work consisted of marking the points as provided in N.R.S. 517.040.

The location and description of each corner and side center, with the markings thereon are: A post of at least 4 inches in diameter by 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet in length has been set up and in the ground or placed in a round of earth or stone 4 feet in diameter by 1 foot in height at the center of each side line and at the corners of this claim, each corner and side center being so marked as to designate such corner and side center of said claim, and such markings were completed within 30 days after the posting of the notice of location.
