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             PHILIP C. HULSE, being first duly sworn, on oath, deposes
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    and says: I am a registered Land Surveyor in the State of Nevada
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    and hold license number 3644. I am also the County Surveyor of
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    Lincoln County, Nevada. I testified as a witness at the trial:
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    of the above-entitled case.
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             On December 16, 1981, I completed a survey of the field
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    belonging to Plaintiffs, WILLIAM C. HOLLINGER and DOLORES Bt.
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HOLLINGER in Ursine, Eagle Valley, Nevada. This is the same field I previously had surveyed for Plaintiff, WILLIAM C. HOLLINGER, which field is enclosed by a fence and which field and fence line I described in my testimony at the trial.

The survey of December 16, 1981 was conducted using a Buff and Burger thirty minute transit and a 200 foot surveyor's chain. The starting point for this survey was the original Southwest corner of Section 35, Township 2 North, Range 69 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian as established in the 1872 survey. This corner is marked by a rock mound.

This is the same corner found by Robert J. McNutt, R.L.S., 1661, as reported on a record of survey map filed in the Lincoln County Courthouse, August 23, 1973, as Plat A, Page 102. This starting point is the same rock mound in which the United States government surveyors set a standard brass cap in 1974.

All courses in the survey were calculated from angle rights were doubled for accuracy and all distances were chained level using plumb-bobs.

Because I believe that the provisions of NRS 625.340 apply to my survey of December 16, 1981, I have recorded a record of this survey in the Lincoln County Recorder's Office on

Feb. 16 , 1982, as N2 74563

The survey of December 16, 1981 was terminated at the Southwest corner of the aforementioned Plaintiff's field at which time a transit-chain and compass survey were made around the existing fence lines of said field which fence lines I understand Judge Hoyt in his decision dated July 30, 1981 determine to be the agreed boundary line.

The legal description, based on this survey of said fence line is as follows:
