SEPARATION AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT entered into this ____ day of Movember, A.D. 1966, by and between ELLEW JOAN EYRAUD, hereinafter called Wife, and RAYMOND L. MYRAUD, hereinafter called Husband.

WHEREAS, certain marital differences have arisen between the parties hereto, the parties no longer living together, and the parties desiring to live separate and apart without further marital obligations, one to the other, except as set forth herein, the parties agree and covenent as follows:

The parties agree and recognize that there are two minor children, born the issue of this marriage, namely: John Raymond Eyraud, aged 18, and Cheryl Byraud, aged 11; that the wife is a fit and proper person to have the care, custody and control of said children; that the husband is able to pay the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per month, being Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per month per child, for the support and maintenance of said children; it is recognised, however, that due to the uncertainties of employment and of physical capacities, the husband may not have employment at all times. During such times the husband shall be excused and not be obligated for the payment of any support.

It is further agreed that the husband shell have the right of reasonable visitation with said children, as that term is recognized and defined under Nevada law.

There is community property consisting of a house and furnishings located on McArthur Drive in Caliente, Nevada. The wife is to have

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and maintain said house and furnishings as her residence until such time as she shall remarry or desire to sell said house. The wife shall make payments on said house in the amount of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) per month for an approximate balance of \$1,500.00. In the event the house is sold before said balance is paid, the proceeds from the sale are first to be used to pay any such balance and then the remainder divided between the parties. On re-marriage, the house shall be advertised for sale and one-half of the proceeds thereof are to be paid to the husband. On any sale other than on re-marriage of the wife, the house shall be sold at the exclusive option of the wife, the husband receiving one-half of the proceeds of said sale.

It is recognised the parties hereto that the house located on Denton Heights in Caliente, Hevada, is and should be the sole and exclusive property of the husband and the wife hereby releases any property interest which she may have in said house to the husband.

The 1960 Chevrolet four-door automobils now owned by the parties shall be the exclusive property of the wife.

There are no community debts of the parties. The savings account owned by the parties as of the date of separation has been used to dispose of said debts.
