MEMORANDUM OF MINING OPTION AND MINERAL LEASE AGREEMENT

THIS MEMORANDUM OF MINING OPTION AND MINERAL LEASE AGREEMENT made as of November 1, 1983, by and between FMC MINERALS CORPORATION ("FMC MINERALS"), a Delaware corporation, having an office at 5011 Meadowood Way, Reno, Nevada 89502, and JAMES W. COLE, doing business as C. & C. MINING AND LAND COMPANY, and Maria Cole, his wife, having an address at 628 Northridge Drive, Boulder City, Nevada 89005 ("OWNER").




