in the Silverhorn Mining District, Lincoln County, Nevada. The number of linear feet claimed in length along the course of the vein each way from the point of discovery is 1450 feet West and 50 feet East together with 300 feet on each side of the middle of the vein, and the general course of the vein is east and west.
