The claim is 1500 feet long and 600 feet wide, and 1500 feet is claimed in a N/S direction and 600 feet in a E/W direction from the location monument, at which the Notice of Location is posted, lengthwise of the claim, together with 300 feet in width on each side of the center of the claim. The general course of the lode deposit and premises is from the S/W to the N/E.

The location and number of each corner of this claim is shown on the claim map that is filed herewith. On the ground, each corner of the claim is marked with its appropriate number by scribing a metal band at the top or back of a 4" by 6" wooden post.

Corner No. 5 is a <u>4x4"</u> wooden post scribed <u>N/S side corner west</u>	<u>Lee-Gold No. 5</u>
Corner No. 6 is a <u>4x4"</u> wooden post scribed <u>N/W corner</u>	<u>Lee-Gold No. 6</u>

The monumentation and marking of the corners was completed by the 14 day of August, 1985.
