This detailed report is filed in compliance with the requirements of Title 30, United States Code, Section 28-1 for the Silver Wedge #1-15, a contiguous group of 15 lode mining claims situated in the Chief (Callente) mining district of Lincoln County, Nevada, for the assessment year ending 1 September 1985.

The work consisted of geological mapping and geochemical sampling of selected portions of the claim group, plus detailed sampling designed to assist in planning further development work, including drilling. The work was performed during a period beginning 10 March 1985 and ending 9 May 1985 by Expiration Research Associates inc., 1701 Clinton Street, Suite 212, Los Angeles, California 90026 under the supervision of Mark A. Liggett (CPGS \$4466). The cost of the work exceeded \$1,500 and was paid for by Mineral Trust Corporation, 1332 Parkview Ave,/Suite 202, Manhattan Beach, CA 90266, lessee of the subject mining claims. Owner of the subject claims is C & C Mining and Land Company, c/o J.M. Cole, P.O. Box 184, Ploche, Nevada 89043.

The geological mapping program included examination and description of rock types and alteration, recording bedding and fault attitudes, and production of a geological map and cross-sections at a scale of 1 inch  $\approx 500$  feet. The geochemical sampling program included the collection of 134 rock chip samples and analyzing them for 10 elements: gold, silver, lead, zinc, copper molybdenum, arsenic, mercury, antimony, and thailium. All of the samples were submitted to Geochemical Services incorporated of Torrance, California, for Inductively-Coupled Plasma (ICP) analysis. Some samples were also sent to Auro-Tech Assaying of Wheat Ridge, Colorado, for fire assay.

Results of the surveys indicate that mineralization may lie at depth in favorable host rocks. Anomalous amounts of precious and trace elements indicate that hydrothermal systems favorable to mineralization have been active along favorable structures within the claims. Based on the results of the surveys, a development program consisting of drilling and sampling is being planned for this property.
