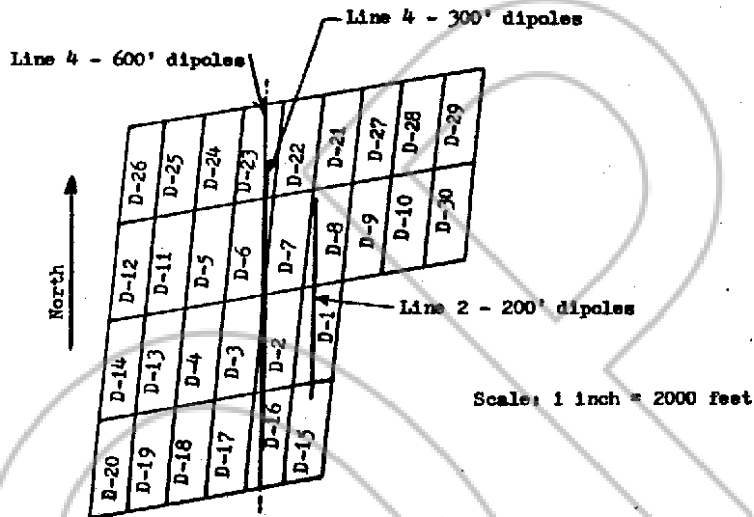

EXHIBIT - A

Induced Polarization and Resistivity Survey
Delta Claims 1 thru 30, Bristol District
Lincoln County, Nevada
Submitted for Assessment Work: 1986.

Phoenix Geophysics Limited of Denver Colorado executed an Induced Polarization and Resistivity survey during the month of November, 1985, on the Delta claim group along two North-South lines that are indicated on the claim map that follows:



The survey was executed using frequency domain equipment operating at 2.5 Hz and 3 Hz. Line 2 was completed with 200 foot dipole spacings and read to N=5. Line 4 was completed using 300 foot dipole spacings and then expanded to 600 foot dipole spacings. Both spreads on Line 4 were read to N=5.

The Phoenix staff evaluated the survey results and concluded that the low PFE responses do not conclusively identify reasonable drill targets and that the variation in PFE responses might correspond to weak sulfide mineralization. Incomplete data suggest a possible anomaly at the south end of Line 2. Resistivity values suggest three rock types underlying the survey area.

The survey was conducted by the following employees of Phoenix Geophysics Limited: Roger Nye, a geophysist; Paul Burns, a geologist; and David Estes, a geophysical technician. The work was witnessed by the owner of the Delta claims, Robert G. Russell, a geologist.
