- (c) Said principal and interest shall be payable as follows:
Interest will be due quarterly from date of note and
principal will be due on or before 1 year.

In all other respects the terms, conditions and provisions of said promissory note and trust deed or mortgage
shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
