

Location Certificate, Lode Claim

The Undersigned hereby certify that they located the Eagle No 1 lode mining claim in the S.W. Quarter, Section 31 Township T3N, Range 71E, <sup>M.D.B.M</sup> in the Unknown mining district, Lincoln County, State of Nevada, on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1987.

The claim is 1500 feet long and 600 feet wide, and 750 feet are claimed in a Easterly direction and 750 feet in a Westerly direction from the location monuments, at which the Location Notice is posted, together with 300 feet in width on each side of the center of the lode.
