CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

We (or) claim 1500 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 1480 feet from the location monument in a North direction, and 20 feet in a South direction, together with 600 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The northwest corner is marked by a Cedar 5' feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the APACHE # 87 Claim;" the southwest corner is marked by a Cedar 5' feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the APACHE # 87 Claim;" the southeast corner is marked by a Cedar 5' feet high, inscribed "SE Corner of the APACHE # 87 Claim;" the northeast corner is marked by a Cedar 5' feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the APACHE # 87 Claim." There is also a Post at the center of each side line.

The monumentation and marking of the corners was completed by the 15th day of August, 1987 (must be within 30 days of posting notice of location)

The location work consisted of making a claim map as provided in NRS 517.040. Two copies of this claim map have been filed with the Lincoln County Recorder, and the \$15.00 lode claim filing fee has been paid to the County Recorder.
