Affiant states that Bayou International, Ltd. has caused, on behalf of Bayou and Bayou's Joint Venture Partner, First Investors Resources, N.L., work to be done on or for the benefit of the above said mining claims adequate to comply with the requirements for the assessment work for the period ending September 1, 1987.

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claims comprising said group as a part of a central plan of development and tend to develop each and all of said mining claims for the purpose of holding each claim in the group.

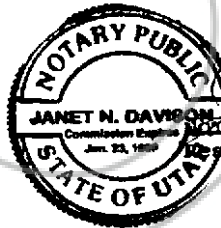
