2. Affiant states that Bayou International, Ltd. has caused, on behalf of Bayou and Bayou's Joint Venture Partner, First Investors Resources, N.L., work to be done on or for the benefit of the above said mining claims adequate to comply with the requirements for the assessment work for the period ending September 1, 1987.

3. Said labor was performed and improvements made at the instance and request of Bayou International, Ltd. and First Investors Resources, N.L., the Lessees of all of the above described mining claims.

4. At least Forty-Four Hundred Dollars (\$4,400.00) was expended by Bayou International, Ltd. and associated parties for labor and improvements for the period ending September 1, 1987.

5. Labor and improvements consisted of removing ore from various claims by Jeffrey L. Sagers and taking it to Salt Lake City for metallurgical processing to ascertain the most economic method of extracting the precious metals values. Said ore was sent to Kircher Ore and Refining Co., Black Canyon Mining Company, H.M.S. Mineral Processing Inc., Walker and Whyte, Inc., Don Warner, and John Adams. At a later date, Robertson Research International, Ltd. was employed to evaluate the ore potential. Richard J. Fletcher, Chief Minerals Geologist, in company with George D. Fehr and Charles Shannon, Geologist, spent several days on the property digging trenches and gathering bulk ore samples which were evaluated at Hydromet, The Assay Lab, Hazen Research and a laboratory in England, and another one in Australia. In addition, samples were sent to Kircher ore and Refining, Inc., Black Canyon Mining Co., and H.M.S. Laboratory.

6. The said mining claims constitute a group or groups of contiguous mining claims leased by said corporations, and the said labor and improvements were done and made for the benefit of each and all of said

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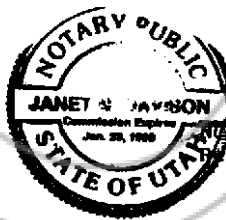
mining claims comprising said group as a part of a central plan of development and tend to develop each and all of said mining claims for the purpose of holding each claim in the group.

7. The value of said work and improvements is not less than Forty-Four Hundred Dollars (\$4,400.00) and not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) for each of the above named mining claims.
