AMENDMENT TO MINING LEASE

(C) Lessee shall pay Lessor a minimum monthly royalty regardless of actual production according to the following schedule:

Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) each and every month for twenty-four months commencing September 1, 1986.

One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or 3 ounces of gold, at the option of the Lessee, or 2.3 ounces of gold, at the option of the Lessor, each and every month thereafter during the life of this Lease, commencing September 1, 1988.

shall be and hereby is amended to read:

(C) Lessee shall pay Lessor a minimum monthly royalty regardless of actual production according to the following schedule:

Four Hundred Dollars (\$400.00) each and every month for sixteen months commencing September 1, 1986.

Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) each and every month for twelve months commencing January 1, 1988.

Twelve Hundred Dollars (\$1,200.00) or 4 ounces of gold, at the option of the Lessee, or 3 ounces of gold, at the option of the Lessor, each and every month thereafter during the life of this Lease, commencing January 1, 1989.

Clause 17 of the Mining Lease which reads as follows:

17. Commencing Operations:

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary provided in Clause 9 above or in any other clause of this Mining Lease, Lessee shall, neverthless, commence or cause to be commenced mining and processing ore from the premises at the rate of 300 or more tons per day for the recovery of precious metals on or before September 1, 1988.

shall be and hereby is amended to read:

17. Commencing Operations:

Notwithstanding anything to the contrary provided in Clause 9 above or in any other clause of this Mining Lease, Lessee shall, neverthless, commence or cause to be commenced mining and processing ore from the premises at the rate of 300 or more tons per day for the recovery of precious metals on or before May 1, 1990.

In all other respects the original Lease executed on the 5th day of August, 1986, by and between the parties hereto remains unchanged, and said Lease as herein amended is now in good standing and in full force and effect.
