That such work was done in September through December of 1987 and May, July and August of 1988.

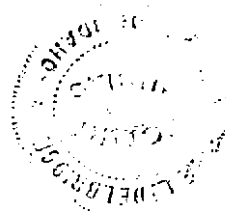
